Who May Apply? All K-12 educators at schools within Sacramento County may apply for a grant.

Project Guidelines: (All projects to culminate with art by elementary age students depicting a creek scene)

- Should include 1 Visual Art and 1 Science teacher
- Students from two different grade levels at least 2 years apart (younger partners to be no older than 6th grade)
- Same or neighboring schools
- Paintings from younger students may be submitted for consideration for the Creek Week 2015 logo.
- Student Art must be highlighted at a school/district-sponsored public exhibit.

Examples of possible projects

- Take a buddy field trip to a creek. Identify creek plants, animals and features, make sketches and take photos.
- Older students teach lessons from the Dipping Into Creeks minicurriculum, available through SACC, or lessons from Project WET.
- Develop and teach a reading/writing lesson using the creek environment as the topic.
- Survey and test the water quality of a creek near school.

Deadline for Application & Project Submission

Applications are due no later than September 26, 2014. Grantees will be notified by October 14, 2014. Funds will be distributed by October 28, 2014.

Projects must be completed and art submitted no later than December 12, 2014.
