Planning for the 23rd Annual Sacramento County Creek Week is underway, and your help is needed for this event's continued success! Sponsor support over the past 22 years has provided tens of thousands of Sacramento citizens the opportunity to actively improve the health and vitality of our urban creeks and, by extension, our community.

With your help, we hope to exceed 2012 Creek Week results, which included:

2,000 volunteers worked along a total of 32 miles of waterways and helped clean a creek this year. They gathered at 62 different locations. Statistics and highlights below:

- o 2,000+ volunteers of all ages and abilities
- \circ Nearly 15 tons of man-made trash removed at 62 clean-up locations
- Approximately 32 miles of waterways improved
- Channels cleared, erosion staved off and room made for native plants by the removal of 115 cubic yards
- o of invasive plants
- Electronic waste found by volunteers was brought to the Celebration for our first-ever E-Waste recycling. 2,600 pounds of e-waste was collected for recycling.

Creek Week's extraordinary efforts enhance the health of our local creeks and increase flood safety by improving stormwater conveyance. The Creek Week tradition of providing public education and stewardship carries on next year. As in previous years, participants will learn about creek protection through following best practices such as proper waste disposal, recycling and using native or drought tolerant plants in home landscaping and public spaces. A new public education component introduced in 2010, water quality testing, will be continued at selected creek sites.

The Creek Week Celebration event will be at Carmichael Park. This lovely park setting allows us to showcase environmental programs from around the Sacramento Area, provides safe parking and plenty of room for growth and inclusion – all to better serve our resident and business volunteers.

CREEK WEEK 2013 OVERVIEW

- Creek Week will begin with the Splash Off on **Friday, April 5, 2013**. During this event, the Creek Steward Award will be presented to a program in recognition of their actions that have benefited our local creeks and environment. In addition, all sponsors will be publicly recognized for their contributions to Creek Week.
- Activities during the days leading up to the cleanup will consist of a variety of nature tours that showcase creeks. Adults and children will learn about the importance of plants and animals inhabiting our creeks and creek corridors and their important roles in the ecosystem.
- Creek Week will culminate on Saturday, April 13, 2013, with volunteers joining to clear trash from more than 50 different creek sites in Sacramento County. Volunteers at some sites will remove invasive non-native plants that overpower native plants and choke our local waterways. Clean-up activities help to maintain or improve the riparian habitat along many stream and creek corridors, provide opportunities to connect people to their natural environment and reduce flood risk. The clean-up will be followed by a celebration complete with food, music, interactive exhibits and contests at Carmichael Park.
